In response to your recent request for information regarding;

The focus of my dissertation revolves around examining the police response to male victims of domestic abuse following the implementation of Clare's Law (2014). Specifically, I am interested in understanding the training protocols in place for addressing the needs of male victims within each of the 43 Home Office forces.

I kindly request details on whether North Wales Police has specific training programs for police staff and officers tailored to male victims of domestic abuse?

Furthermore, if such training initiatives exist, I am interested in understanding the rationale behind their introduction. Were there any specific incidents that prompted a reassessment of policy and procedures leading to the implementation of this specialised training?

The DA Matters training uses the voice of the male victims in the example scenarios alongside the voices of a variety of victims.

We provide more information on male victims during the DA Matters Champions Training which is an optional addition.
