2024/251 - Figures of FPN's Issued Since 20mph began

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

How many FPN's have been issued via speed camera's in Oakenholt, and Sychden, from 1st December 2023 to 27th February 2024 for speeding over the 20mph default speed limit.

From the 1st December 2023 to 27th of February 2024 how many FPN's were issued from speed camera's in Flintshire.

How many FPN's have been issued by traffic police for exceeding the 20mph default speed limit from the 1st December 2023 to 27th February 2024 in Flintshire.

What is the maximum speed you can do, before the speed camera's or traffic police can issue fines?

If it is not clear were it is 20mph, and you are driving above that speed, can you still be given a FPN?

Police are monitoring complaints of speeding in 20mph, and will assess the threat of risk/harm in 'new' 20mph limits. No enforcement will take place without advance notice to the public. Enforcement is taking place in 20mph speed limits which were 20mph speed limits with approved enforcement locations prior to September 2023. Engagement remains the primary response from policing to the implementation of a default speed limit of 20mph in Wales.
