In response to your recent request for information regarding;

How often are PNC/PND records reviewed?

PNC

We do not delete PNC records with convictions on them – they weed off normally when the person is aged 100 years old, this is managed by Hendon.
The only time records get deleted is if we find it has being created in error and we transfer the details to the correct record and we have to add a comment to why this is being done.

When a PNC record is created for a missing person who is later found when this is updated it will delete off the record in full if there is only the WM (wanted/missing) on for that person.

PND

PND is not subject of any 'review'. The information held in PND reflects that held on the source systems in the respective forces and organisations that share their data with PND. Any review would be undertaken in a force/organisation and then under the MoPI Guidance.
