Please note: Injury road traffic collision (RTC) data is sourced from the Home Office Stat19 returns for the period of 01/01/2019 to 31/07/2024.

2023 and 2024 data is provisional and is therefore subject to change.

There is no specific field within the stats 19 defines Electric Pedal Cycles and are recorded as pedal cycles. There is no specific field within the stats 19 that defines E-Scooters and are normally recorded as other. As such to ensure that all the information required was captured a word search was also carried out. Due to a word search requirement all incidents involving e-scooters or e-bikes may not be captured.

Please note, due to the requested time periods there may be duplicates due to the data for July 26 of 2020-2023 being requested twice.
