Year	Month	HO Description	Summary
2022	April	Other criminal damage, other (Under £5000.00 damage)	Informant reporting that the charging station has been damaged by youths
2022	August	Other criminal damage, other (Under £5000.00 damage)	Caller reporting that in December last year the EV charge points at the location address were damaged. They have since been removed to make safe.
2022	August	Other criminal damage, other (Over £5000.00 damage)	During December 2021 the Electric Vehicle charger has been damaged
2022	November	Other criminal damage, other (Under £5000.00 damage)	reporting that an EV charging point has been damaged in car park at the location. Unknown exactly when this has taken place
2023	April	Other criminal damage, other (Under £5000.00 damage)	Person reporting unknown person has caused damage to electric car chargers at the car park at location
2023	May	Other criminal damage to a vehicle (Under £5000.00 damage)	Electric Car recharger door/housing damaged and hanging off, looks like it's been forced open and snapped off.
2023	August	Other criminal damage to a vehicle (Under £5000.00 damage)	WHISLT IP HAS LEFT HIS VEHICLE CHARGING UNKNOWN OFFENDER HAS SNAPPED CHARGING HATCH OFF THEIR VEHICLE CAUSING DAMAGE TO VEHICLE.
2024	February	Other criminal damage, other (Under £5000.00 damage)	IP REPORTING DAMAGE CAUSED TO BATTERY CHARGER (FOR VAN) - ALL WIRES CUT . THE CHARGER WAS KEPT IN CAR PORT.
