We do not have a mental health triage care in place, but do have a welfare support team who provide basic 1:1 support for police officers/police staff experiencing mental health issues and offer drop-in sessions within the force for Rotas/departments/Teams to attend, informal and formal debriefs, psychosocial education, workshops on resilience, depression/anxiety/stress management, PTSD.

The team consists of one welfare lead and three welfare and engagement welfare officers who work on a flexi rota 6am-10pm when required. This was set up 2018.
