2025/1097 - Victims' Right to Review (VRR) scheme

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

The total number of VRR requests received by North Wales Police during the most recent 12-month period for which data is available.

Between 1 October 2024 and 30 September 2025 there were a total of 114 applications received for VRR

The number of these VRR requests that were completed after the statutory three-month timeframe.

Of the 114 applications received, as at 20/10/25, there were 12 completed outside of the statutory three-month timeframe.

Data Caveats;

- Please note that of the 114 applications received, there are 13 applications currently outstanding, these are applications received in recent months and currently still within the three-month timeframe to respond (i.e. an application received on 30 September 2025 has until 30 December 2025 to respond and be within the three-months timeframe)
- Please note the data is based on the timeframe from receipt of application to initial response and does not include the timeframe for VRR cases that are upheld and re-opened for further enquiries.

If it is not possible to provide the exact number of VRR requests completed after three months, I would appreciate any available information on the average time taken to process VRR requests during this period.
