In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I am a student in the United States working on a project concerning militant nationalism. I saw a comprehensive list of arson attacks associated with Meibion Glyndwr in Freedom Fighters by John Humphries that was provided by Gwynedd Police. I was wondering if that list is still available online anywhere or has any updates.

We are not aware that such a list exists/is held by North Wales Police.

However, to even comply with Section 1 (1) (1) of the Freedom of Information Legislation (which is the duty to inform the applicant whether or not information is held by the authority) would be above the amount to which we are legally required to respond i.e. the cost of retrieving the information exceeds the 'appropriate level' as stated in the Freedom of Information (FOI) Fees and Appropriate Limit regulations 2004.

Therefore, in accordance with the FOI Act 2000 the information you have requested is exempt under Section 12 (2), and this letter acts as a Refusal Notice under section 17 (5) of the legislation.
