2025/495 - Offenders' missing/out-of-date information

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

Please note: we can only provide information on those individuals on ViSOR who are registered sex offenders or individuals who have been made subject of a sexual risk order and are subject of notification requirements, and as a result have to register home address details with Police within 3 days of this information changing.

- How many offenders on the VSOR fall within the force's area of responsibility for up-to-date information?

As of today's date, North Wales Police manage 1086 individuals who are subject of the notification requirements. This figure is in relation to those who are currently out in the community. Those in custody have not been included.

- If available within FOI limits, how many of these offenders are on the register for sexual offences?

As of today's date 1080 are on the register for sexual offences.

- How many offenders on the VSOR have missing, incomplete, or out-of-date location information (workplace, home setting, etc.)?

The above figures are in relation to those individuals who are wanted on PNC as whereabouts are unknown due to the individual not registering the details:

- If available within the FOI limits, how many offenders on the VSOR are registered for sexual offences and have missing, incomplete, or out-of-date location information?
