2025/977 - Stalking protection order

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

- 1. I wish to know what is the longest time and the average time between the relevant allegation of crime being reported to NWP and an interim stalking protection order being applied for in a court by NWP for that reported crime for the last ten years.**
- 2. I wish to know the shortest time and the average time between the relevant allegation of a crime being reported to NWP and a full stalking protection order being applied for by NWP for that reported crime for the last ten years.**

Please note we have looked at stalking crimes and associated SPO applications.

Interim SPO - longest time from report to police to interim granted – 67 Days, Avg time: 54 days

Full SPO - shortest time from report to police to full granted (I've only taken straight to Full applications and not interims SPO's and then full applications) - shortest time 43 days, average time 135 days - some of the full SPO's applications experienced delays in proceeding to court due to respondents being sectioned within hospital.
