In response to your recent request for information regarding;

For the period 1 January 2024 to 12 January 2026, I respectfully request an index or list (where maintained) of incidents in which body-worn camera footage has been cleared, approved, or otherwise deemed releasable for public disclosure.

Where available and legally releasable, please include:

- **Date of incident**
- **General location (district, area, or nearest public description)**
- **Incident category/type (e.g. pursuit, arrest, weapons recovery, DUI, use of force)**
- **Reference, case, or event number required to request the corresponding footage**

If no complete index is maintained, I would appreciate the same information for:

- **Commonly disclosed categories (pursuits, DUI arrests, weapons recoveries, violent arrests), or**
- **The most recent 100 incidents in which body-worn footage has been cleared for release.**

North Wales Police (NWP) do not hold a list/index of cleared/approved Body Worn video (BWV) footage for public disclosure.

Officers supply dashcam and BWV for news releases and we also use them for Llinell Las. Our most commonly disclosed categories for BWV would be significant arrests and significant warrants. Most of these would be on our Facebook account and therefore publically accessible.
