Please provide the following information for all Police Force owned and operated buildings in your area:

- 1. The total number of separately metered buildings as of the most recent date available for the calendar year 2025:**

January 2025 to December 2025, invoiced electricity supply = 58 meters (16 HH and 42nHH)

- 2. The aggregate annual electricity standing charges paid for all buildings.**

January 2025 to December 2025, invoiced electricity supply = £198,087.87 for standing charges

- 3. The total electricity consumption, in kilowatt-hours (kWh), across all buildings.**

January 2025 to December 2025, invoiced electricity supply = 5,738,657 kWh consumption
