A copy of your force's policy(ies) regarding the release of video or audio footage (including bodycam footage, CCTV, and other recordings) to external organisations, particularly those that may use the footage for commercial gain.

North Wales Police do not have a policy, we follow the College of Policing Media APP guidance in relation to the release of images and footage.

- The type of organisation (e.g., media, entertainment, commercial)
- The purpose of the release (e.g., broadcasting, advertising)
- The nature of the footage released

Please provide any relevant documents, reports, or records related to these requests. I add that with regards to the historic instance, as mentioned above, it would only seem relevant in relation to my questions, to cover the last ten years.

We will release, when there is a policing purpose to do so, to news outlets and production companies as appropriate.

We do not currently charge for the release of images or footage to any organisation.
