In response to your recent request for information regarding;

The location where these speeding fine letters are printed.

The address or facility from which these letters are dispatched.

The postal service and the sorting office through which these letters are processed.

Any known issues or common reasons that might cause these letters not to reach their intended recipients.

Speeding notices and associated letters are printed, enveloped, and prepared for dispatch from DHQ St Asaph. Once prepared, the mail is taken to the reception area at DHQ, St Asaph, where it is franked and collected by Royal Mail for delivery.

We are unable to comment on Royal Mail's internal sorting processes, operational processes or the specific reasons why an item of post may not reach its intended recipient, including which sorting office may handle the mail or the specific routing used, as this falls outside the remit of the Police and is not information we hold.
