In response to your recent request for information;

- 1) In 2023, 2024 and 2025 (calendar years), how many hit-and-run cases were reported to your force?**
- 2) In 2023, 2024, and 2025 (calendar years), how many hit-and-run casualties were recorded by your force?**
- 3) In 2023, 2024, and 2025 (calendar years), how many hit-and-run fatalities were recorded by your force?**

Method

The injury road traffic collision (RTC) data is sourced from the Home Office Stats19 returns for the period of 01/01/2023 – 31/12/2025. Please note that 2025 data is considered provisional, therefore subject to change. This data has been broken down to show "1 – Hit and Run" as per the stats 19 recording for all injury collisions and further broken down to year and severity. This data also shows the number of collisions along with the number of casualties as a result of the hit and run.

The query includes all vehicle type recorded under the stat19 which included pedal cyclist, other non-motor vehicle, tram, ridden horse etc
