The total number of cases of livestock theft- specifically relating to Sheep reported in the calendar year 2025 (01.01.25- 31.12.25) across the North Wales Police Force area.

Jan-25	049/10	IP reporting theft of 12 of his lambs which are £100 each from the location.
Mar-25	049/10	UNKNOWN OFFENDER HAS STOLEN 5 SHEEP BY UNKNOWN MEANS.
Apr-25	049/10	Theft of 26 sheep from common land.
Jun-25	039/00	Farmer reporting a number of sheep (approx. 52) having been stolen from fields at location STB Mar - June 2025.
Jun-25	049/10	IP reports their sheepdog has been stolen from field
Jul-25	049/10	IP reporting the theft of 28 sheep and some lambs off the mountain
Aug-25	049/10	IP reports that ewes and lambs have been stolen from his land.
Aug-25	049/10	Unknown offender(s) have attempted to steal sheep from the location.
Aug-25	049/10	Ip reports known offender has stole4-5 sheep hurdles.
Sep-25	049/10	IP reports two Welsh Mountain Rams stolen from his pasture land.

Nov-25	049/10	IP REPORTING HE SENT 219 SHEEP UP TO LOCATION. . 52 ARE NOW MISSING.
Nov-25	049/10	Person reporting theft of 20 sheep
Dec-25	049/10	STOLEN SEVERAL SHEEP BY REMOVING THEM FROM HIS LAND, CAUSING HARASSMENT, ALARM AND DISTRESS. THEFT OF 6 SHEEP FROM FIELD
Dec-25	049/10	IP reporting that 54 lambs have been stolen from the field.
Dec-25	049/10	Officer reporting the theft of 5 x Lambs from a field over the last 3 weeks valued at approx £120-£130 each.
