In response to your recent request for information regarding;

Relevant timeframe is from 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2019:

(i) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to police use of cctv on the highway approaching Dalar Hir DVSA site and at the Dalar Hir site.

(ii) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to police use of dash cam and body cam on the highway approaching Dalar Hir DVSA site and at the Dalar Hir site.

(iii) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to police retention of such cctv footage in cases of intended prosecution.

(iv) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to police retention of such dash cam and body cam footage in cases of intended prosecution.

(v) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to police taking of digital images/photographs of vehicles and/or vehicle loads on the highway approaching Dalar Hir DVSA site and at the Dalar Hir site in cases of intended prosecution.

(vi) copies of the policies and procedures (published or not) in relation to the preservation and chain of custody of the native/original digital photographs taken by police on the highway approaching Dalar Hir DVSA site and at the Dalar Hir site of vehicles and/or vehicle loads in cases of intended prosecution.

(vii) copies of data showing the number of cctv cameras and their locations on the highway approaching Dalar Hir DVSA site and at the Dalar Hir site.
