2026/813 - Welsh nationalist militant activity

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I am researching the policing and security response to Welsh nationalist militant activity surrounding the Investiture of HRH Prince Charles at Caernarfon Castle on 1 July 1969.

I would like to know whether North Wales Police holds any surviving records relating to the investigation of bomb attacks connected with Mudiad Amddiffyn Cymru (MAC), the Free Wales Army (FWA), or other Welsh nationalist groups during the period 1 January 1968 to 31 December 1970.

If such records exist, I request copies of any material that can be disclosed, including:

- * Investigation reports**
- * Incident logs**
- * Crime scene or bomb disposal reports**
- * Photographs**
- * Evidence inventories**
- * Intelligence assessments produced by North Wales Police**
- * Correspondence with the Home Office, Ministry of Defence or other police forces**
- * Security briefings relating to the Investiture**
- * Reports relating to the Abergele, Caernarfon and Llandudno Pier bomb incidents**

If any records have been transferred to another archive, destroyed, or are otherwise no longer held, I would be grateful if you could advise where they were transferred or when they were disposed of.

No information is held in relation to your request.
