2026/848 - Road safety of Park Road and Mill, Lane, Top Bradley, LL11 4DF

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I lead a large group of stakeholders and others who are campaigning to improve the road safety of Park Road and Mill, Lane, Top Bradley, LL11 4DF, in conjunction with [REDACTED] MP and [REDACTED] MS.

The dangers were highlighted when a local Councillor [REDACTED] sustained life changing injuries when her back was broken in three places. Councillor [REDACTED] was thrown off her horse when a speeding car panicked it, throwing her into the road. The driver failed to stop.

These roads pass through the Alyn Waters Country Park, Wrexham, and despite the habitual use of thousands of visitors per year on foot, cycle and horseback too, it is the only road in Wrexham's parks left unrestricted with a 60mph speed limit.

We are aware of a large number of adverse incidents, near misses, speeding complaints and also injuries sustained by other horse riders and we will be very grateful if you can supply details of these incidents please so that [REDACTED] can make representations to Wrexham County Borough Council on our behalf please.

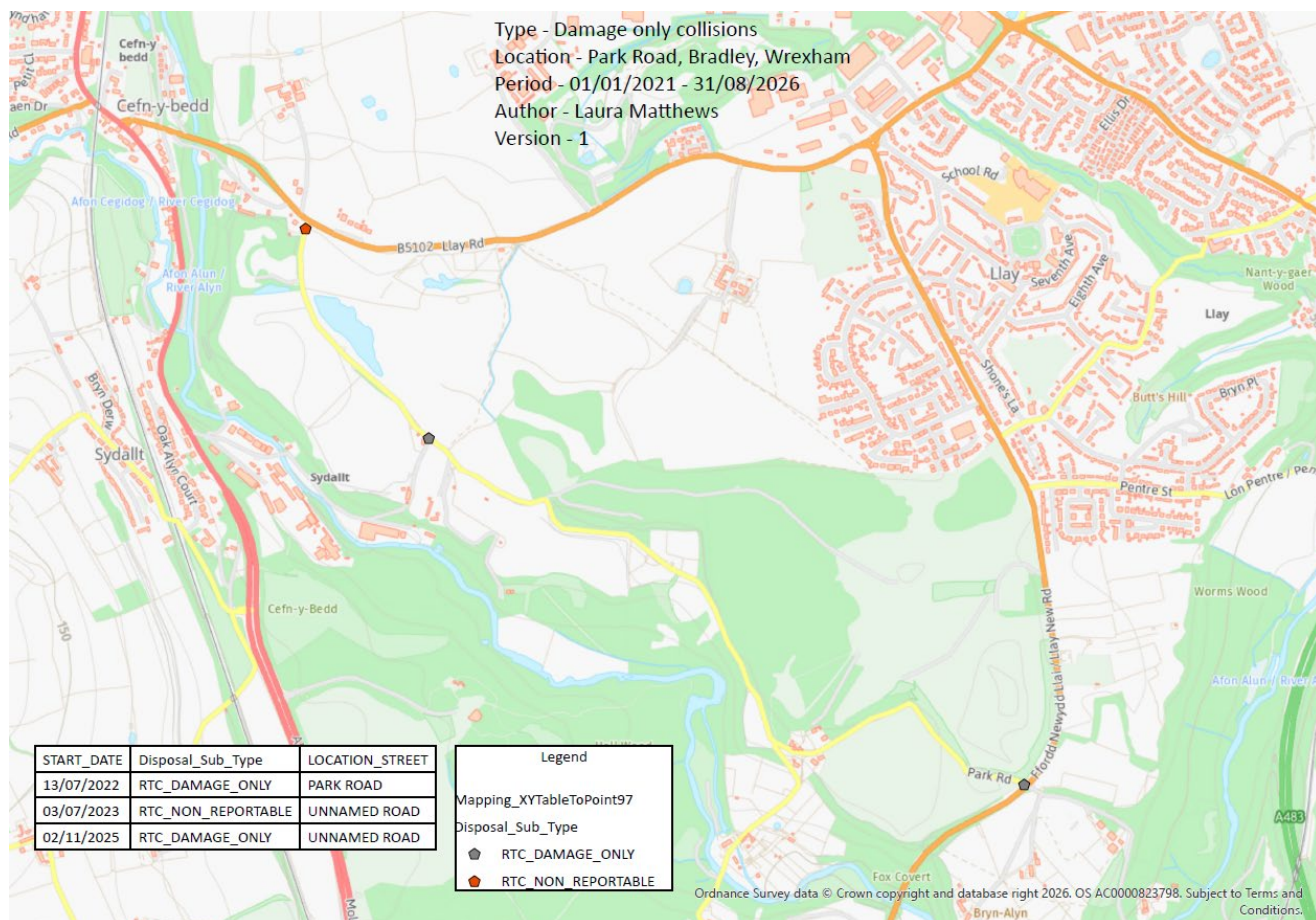
Go safe have advised of one speeding complaint for this area in the last three years.

We have searched our Record Management system (RMS) which records crime and occurrences and our ICAD system which recorded calls/incidents. In relation to this area there were none linked to horses.

There have been no injury collisions on Park Road, Bradley in the 5-year period reviewed and I am unable to locate Mill Lane on any of our mapping systems. There have been 2 damage only and 1 non-reportable collisions on this road with none of them involving horse riders [1 in 2022, 1 in 2023 and 1 in 2025] as shown in the below map:

There have been 5 adverse incidents reported during the above period on Park Road. One being a police pursuit which involved excess speed, one dangerous driver resulting in a near miss, one drink driver, one near miss due to traffic being diverted to the area and one parking on a blind bend.
