In response to your recent request for information regarding;

For the period 1 January 2026 to 30 June 2026 inclusive, please provide the number of individuals serving or employed by your force who were charged with, or summoned to court for, a criminal offence during that period.

Please provide the figures separately, where held, for:

**Police officers;
Special constables; and
Police staff.**

I am seeking the number of individuals, not the number of individual charges or offences. Therefore, where one person was charged with multiple offences during the period, please count that person once.

I am not requesting names, ranks, collar numbers, details of the alleged offences, case files, misconduct records or any other personal information.

I am also not requesting information about individuals who were arrested but were not charged or summonsed during the specified period.

If the information is not held in a way that allows the three categories above to be separated without exceeding the appropriate cost limit, please provide the total number of individuals across the categories where that total is readily available.

North Wales Police (NWP) have a nil return for the requested data. We have searched for occurrences with a filed date in 2026 + linked offender nominal where employment details are recorded. We have also searched custody records for any nominals with an MG4 disposal report in 2026 and the detainee has an employee flag – both coming up as nil return. We are limited to searching for offences reported to NWP and where the employment details/employee flags is available.
