1. In what year did your force start recording non-crime hate incidents?

We started recording NCHI as far back as 2005, limited amounts however these naturally increased as we started to record more non crime incidents on our record management system.

2. Please provide any document laying out the policy for recording such incidents?

No policy as such, we follow the (NSIR) National Standard of Incident Recording and (NCRS) National Crime Recording Standard. In North Wales we have always recorded some of our non-crime incidents which include hate related incidents and hate related incidents which could come in as ASB interface onto our record management system.

2. Please provide any email or document instructing your force to record such incidents, from for example the Home Office, Association of Chief Police Officers etc?

As above we have always recorded hate incidents, but when the code was amended in 2023 all relevant College Of Policing guidance was communicated with the force.
