In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding speed and traffic surveys carried out on Coed Onn Road, Flint, Flintshire, and its surrounding routes.

Through correspondence kindly shared with me [REDACTED], I understand that GoSafe conducted two speed monitoring surveys on Coed Onn Road during the following periods:

- **13th January 2023 to 20th January 2023**
- **16th February 2023 to 22nd February 2023**

I want to request:

- **Details of any further traffic or speed surveys carried out on Coed Onn Road or adjoining/connecting roads(e.g. Prince of Wales Avenue, Chester Road, Windsor Drive, or routes connecting to Oakenholt) since February 2023**

GoSafe have not carried out any further surveys at this location or in the surrounding area towards Oakenholt.

- **Full datasets or reports from any such surveys, including similar breakdowns of traffic volume, vehicle type, speeds, and time-of-day data where available.**
