In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I would like to request information relating to traffic congestion in Towyn, particularly in relation to Tir Prince Market and events held at the site.

Specifically, I would like to know:

How many incidents, if any, have been recorded within the last three years where traffic congestion in Towyn has impacted emergency response times.

Whether your organisation holds any records, reports, complaints, risk assessments, or internal correspondence regarding congestion affecting access for emergency vehicles in Towyn.

Whether any concerns have been raised by operational staff regarding traffic queues extending onto the A548, Sandbank Road, or Sandbank Bridge.

Whether any meetings, discussions, correspondence, or reports have taken place between your organisation and Conwy County Borough Council, Tir Prince, or any other organisation regarding traffic management in the area.

Copies of any studies, assessments, reports, emails, or data held relating to the impact of traffic congestion on emergency service response times in Towyn.

Details of any occasions where emergency vehicles have experienced delays, diversions, or difficulties accessing incidents due to congestion in the Towyn area.

We wouldn't hold such specific information.

From a meeting point of view – We are not aware of the local policing team attending any meetings.

This area is not showing as an area that is generating a high degree of collisions either.
