In response to your recent request for information regarding;

I would like to know when Wrexham Council confirmed to the police that they had no intention of removing the flags illegally erected by Wrexham Unite.

This statement was made, on camera, by one of your officers and I would like to see the official notification from the Council and any subsequent means this was relayed to officers internally.

There has been no notification to North Wales Police from Wrexham Local Authority that they have had no intention of removing flags. North Wales Police has been clear that, unless there is an immediate risk to public safety, the removal of flags is not a police matter.
